NEW SERVICE TIMES:

Beginning in July, our Sunday Service times will be shifted to accommodate the growth of our congregation:

1st Service: 9:30 AM
2nd Service: 11:00 AM

Rationale:

- Our current facilities were designed to accommodate a congregation of 800
- Currently the ratio between our two services is about 3:1
- Most of the growth and bringing is taking place in our 2nd service
- There are Sundays where our 2nd service is nearing its capacity
- Cultural realities indicate a decided preference for later starting times

- According to the Congregational Survey of over 130 people, the most balanced of service times was the 9:00 & 11:00 AM slots
- In order to maximize our current facilities and create space for growth, it is vital that we achieve more of an attendance balance between our services.
- Growing our congregation to 800 will enable the next step in our Master Plan Campus – a permanent sanctuary – to become a reality

Comments:

- The proposed changes will require reducing our between service turnaround time from 30 minutes to 20 minutes and reducing the programmed length of our services from 75 minutes to 70 minutes.
- Volunteers who serve in one service and worship in the other will actually reduce their overall time commitment, as well as enjoy a later start time.
- FamJam will now begin at 10:00 AM with doors opening at 9:30 AM
- These changes will begin effective July 5, 2009

REPORT FROM DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT

- District Conference will be hosted by CCCC June 11-13 and will feature the ordination of our student ministries pastor, Scott Stevenson on Friday, June 12.
